SPC19 CRIME/NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH

No crime report had been received but Cllr Henry Hobhouse reported that he met with the new Police Sergeant who confirmed that four new Police Officers had moved into the Somerton area team. A long discussion had taken place about issues on the A359 and it was reported that Queen Camel Parish Council has agreed to pay for Police presence on the bridge.

SPC20 SOMERSET COUNCILLORS

Cllr Henry Hobhouse reported that Somerset Council saved £35million on the 2024/25 budget. Cllr Mike Best reported that Adult Social Care is one of the biggest drains on the budget but although costs were high when the five Councils moved to a Unitary they have managed to achieve savings. This was helped by selling assets and being given a dispensation to use capital income as revenue.

There was no update. A major crack on the bridge had been reported. Concerns were raised about speeding on the High Street. Cllr Mike Best agreed to raise a query about Police presence at Parish Council meetings.
